Auditions for the 2008 Avon Community Heritage Festival Talent show will be held September 13, from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. at the Avon United Methodist Church, U.S. 36.

According to PZ Sinclair, Board Member, “Any resident of the greater Avon and surrounding area may enter the contest, which offers a first prize of \$250, second prize of \$100 and third prize of \$50. In the past, singers, musicians, dancers, jugglers, comedians, and even a clogging act have performed at the talent show.”

The talent show, now in its fourth year, was originally born from the TV show American idol.

Ten adults ages 16 and older and 10 children ages 3 to 15 will be chosen from the auditions to advance to the semi-finals at 6 p.m. Sept. 26, the night before the festival, at Harmony Baptist Church. From semi-finals, five performers from each age group will compete at 7 p.m. September 27 at Washington Township Park.

“We have a lot of stars in Hendricks County,” said Don Hodson, Avon Heritage Festival Board President. “This is where they can shine!”

All entries must pre-register on line at www.avonchamber.org by September 1. Each act is limited to five minutes. No former first-place winners may participate.

Performers must furnish all props. The festival committee will provide the stage, electricity, cassette/CD player, and a microphone and sound system. Talent must be amateur.
